IN GRADE 11 AND MISSING VACCINES? WE CAN HELP!

York Region Public Health is holding an immunization clinic for Grade 11s (students born in 2008) at your school.

Vaccines for measles, mumps, rubella, varicella, tetanus, diphtheria, pertussis, polio and meningitis (Men ACYW135), as well as HPV (human papillomavirus) and Hepatis B will be available at this clinic.

Having up-to-date immunizations helps ensure children have the best protection possible against certain vaccine-preventable diseases that can be very serious or even fatal. It also reduces the risk of disease outbreaks in schools to help maintain a safe and healthy school environment. The *Immunization of School Pupils Act* (ISPA) requires parents/guardians to provide proof of immunization for certain diseases if their children attend school in Ontario. Every year, York Region Public Health collects and reviews the immunization information of York Region students so that their immunizations are up-to-date according to Ontario's Immunization Schedule.

Is my child missing a vaccine?
